### **JOINT COMMONWEALTH ORGANISATIONS**

**Visit to the City of London**

**to be held on Thursday 10th May 2018**

The JCO event for 2018 will be to the City of London. It will begin with a guided tour of Guildhall, the ceremonial and administrative centre of the City of London Corporation. This is a Grade I listed building, dating back to the 15th century. It is the only non-ecclesiastical stone building in London of its age to have survived to the present day, although it did not completely escape the ravages of the Great Fire of London in 1666. The term 'Guildhall' refers not only to the building itself, but also to the main room, which is a mediaeval Great Hall. This is on the site of an earlier building and the term "guildhall" is believed to be derived from the Anglo-Saxon term "gild" meaning payment, and therefore, somewhere where people paid their taxes. The building hosts many functions during the year, the most notable of which is the Lord Mayor's Banquet, hosted by the incoming Lord Mayor in honour of the outgoing Lord Mayor.

The tour will be followed by a buffet lunch in Pewterers' Hall, belonging to the Worshipful Company of Pewterers, one of the oldest livery companies in the City of London. The livery company ranks 16th in precedence of London livery companies, and dates back to at least 1348. The current Pewterers' Hall is its third incarnation and dates back to 1961, the two previous halls having been destroyed by fire.

After lunch there is an opportunity for those who wish to visit the Church of St Lawrence Jewry. Originally built in the 12th century, the church was destroyed in the Great Fire of London and rebuilt to designs of Sir Christopher Wren. The name of the church reflects the fact that it was built on the edge of the mediaeval Jewish district, but it is now the official church of the Corporation of London. Canon Parrott is happy to give a talk about the church.
