**The Bank of England, past and present
to be held on Wednesday 1st May 2019 at 11am**

The JCO event this spring will start with a visit to the Bank of England Museum for a relaxed, seated presentation in a special cinema about the Bank's history since its foundation in 1694. It also focuses on the main roles and functions of the Bank today. The presentation lasts an hour, and a hearing loop is available in the cinema. There will be an opportunity to ask questions afterwards, and also time to browse the museum displays. The visit continues with a two- or three-course private lunch with wine at The Mercer, a two-minute walk from the Bank, and menu selections and additional information will be available nearer the event.

Should you wish to explore the area independently after lunch, there are a number of options available within a short walk. These include St Paul's Cathedral, the Tower of London, the London Mithraeum Museum, the Globe Theatre and the London Troops War Memorial.

As neither the menu nor the exact costings are yet confirmed, we are asking members who may be interested in attending to complete the form over-leaf. The Victoria League will be handling the payments, but please send your registration form to Margaret Pinder as soon as possible, and to arrive no later than 15th January 2019. Application forms will be sent to all those who express an interest, as soon as full details are available.
